


Chamber Desks delivering action


- The Entrepreneurship Desk has grown to 440 registered business, with 73% black-owned and 54% female-owned.
- Our strategic initiatives manager Lunga Mjodo has joined the steering committee of the Department of Science, Technology and Innovation - CSIR Nanotechnology Innovation Centre's Enterprise Programme.
- We hosted the Nelson Mandela Bay edition of the Entrepreneur Programme awards and exhibition, in partnership with the Airports Company of SA. The attendees and exhibitors at the event included the 21 local businesses who successfully completed the programme. This has delivered additional benefits with several participants being invited to join the ACSA supplier development programme, providing potential opportunities to supply products to the company.

- We are delighted that of the 21 Youth Employment Service (YES) interns placed with our member companies this year, seven have been permanently employed and one has had their contract extended.
